



Dr. AIDAN HOLLIS, PH.D

**D**r. Aidan Hollis, an internationally renowned expert in the field of Health Economics is presently the T. D. Mac Donald Chair of Industrial Economics at the Competition Bureau, Ottawa.

*Dr. Aidan Hollis was educated at Cambridge University and the University of Toronto, where he obtained his PhD in Economics in 1996. Since then he has taught graduate and undergraduate courses and supervised graduate students at the University of Calgary, where he holds the position of Associate Professor of Economics. In 2002 he was named a Fellow of the Institute of Health Economics in Alberta. Dr. Hollis was appointed to the position of T.D. MacDonald Chair of Industrial Economics at the Competition Bureau, Ottawa, for the year 2003-4, where he provides economic advice on enforcement and policy issues.*

*Dr. Hollis has published extensively in economics, particularly focusing in issues related to competition in pharmaceutical markets. However, he has also published articles in diverse fields including competition policy, micro finance, labour economics, and intellectual property rights, and he has made over 40 academic presentations in universities and research conferences.*

*Dr. Aidan Hollis has been selected by the World Scientist Forum for "Eminent Scientist of the Year 2004" International Award based on his unique contribution in Health Economics and his wide knowledge in Economics related to competition in pharmaceutical markets.*
