



Dr. EUGENE HERN CHOON LIU

*Dr. E. H. C. Liu, MBChB, MPhil, FRCA, a reputed specialist in Anaesthesiology, is currently working as a consultant anaesthetist at the National University Hospital in Singapore. He works in a full range of anaesthesia, with a focus on anaesthesia for spine surgery.*

*His undergraduate medical training was at the University of Leicester, and his postgraduate training in epidemiology was at the University of Cambridge, UK. He specialised in anaesthesia and subspecialised in cardiothoracic anaesthesia in hospitals in Cambridge and London.*

*He teaches undergraduate medical students at the National University of Singapore, in the operating rooms and in simulator training sessions. He is the Director of Postgraduate Education for anaesthesia in NUH, planning, organising and teaching in several programmes for junior and senior trainees, and specialists. He has also taught in Myanmar, Nepal and Vietnam on medical aid programmes, and also teach evidence based medicine.*

*His responsibilities include: examiner for the Master of Medicine in Anaesthesia (NUS), member of the training and examination*

*subcommittees of the Specialist Training Committee in Singapore, and Editorial board member of the Singapore Medical Journal.*

*His current research work is in the behavioural aspects of novel neuropeptides involved in pain. He also works on systematic reviews and works with the Cochrane Collaboration. He has published 20 papers and holds 3 grants.*
