



Prof. KJELL ÖBERG

Prof. Kjell Erik Öberg, an eminent internationally reputed veteran in the field of Oncology, is presently the Professor of Endocrine Oncology and the Dean of the Medical Faculty, Uppsala University, Sweden. Prof. Öberg was born on 15th April 1946, in Kalix, Sweden.

Prof. Öberg completed his Medical studies at the Universities of Gothenburg and Umeå (1965-1971). He received his MD Degree from Umeå in 1971 and Ph.D from Uppsala University in 1982. He specialized in general internal medicine in 1976 from the Central Hospital of Boden and endocrinology in 1981 from Uppsala University, Department of Endocrinology. He was a Consultant in Endocrinology from 1982-1986 and was the Head of the Clinical branch, Ludwig Institute for Cancer Research, Uppsala University Hospital from 1986-1992. Since 1986, Prof. Öberg became the Head and Chairman of the National Referral Center for Neuroendocrine Tumors in Sweden at Uppsala University Hospital. In 1996 he was the Professor of Endocrine Oncology and in 1998 Chairman of the Department of Medical Sciences at Uppsala University.

Prof. Öberg has published more than 300 papers on basic and clinical science within the field of neuroendocrine tumors. He served as the President of European Neuroendocrine Tumor Network since 1997 and Chairman of the Nordic Neuroendocrine Tumor Network since 1999. Prof. Öberg was also the Chairman of the Advisory Board for Somatostatin analogs in neuroendocrine tumors for Novartis, Basel, since 2000.

Prof. Öberg was selected by the World Scientists Forum for "Eminent Scientist of the Year 2003" international award for his research innovations and outstanding contributions in the field of neuroendocrine
